Dr. Jorge L. Orbay received his medical doctorate at the University of Puerto Rico in 1983. He subsequently completed his orthopaedic residency training at the prestigious Hospital for Joint Diseases in New York, NY, and completed his Hand Fellowship training at the University of Miami at Jackson Memorial Hospital.

Immediately thereafter, Dr. Orbay founded the Miami Hand Center and served as its Medical Director until 2009. He then founded The Hand Institute, where he currently serves as Medical Director. Dr. Orbay has been invited to speak at numerous regional, national and international meetings and is well published. Most notably, Dr. Orbay popularized the technique of volar plate fixation for distal radius fractures, truly revolutionizing orthopaedic care for one of the most common upper extremity injuries. Dr. Orbay continues to innovate and is currently the director of Skeletal Dynamics, which has produced novel approaches to upper extremity reconstruction.
